Other Rules & Regulations:

- 1. Time Control: 25 min + 5 sec increment
- 2. System of Play: The tournament will be conducted as per latest FIDE Laws of Chess and in Swiss system Nine (9) Rounds.
- 3. Tie-Break: Latest FIDE Rules applicable (Buchholz) declared by the Chief Arbiter in Technical Meeting with players.
- 4. Protest: Protest if any against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 1,000/- within 10 minutes of the occurrence of the incident to the appeals committee. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld. 5 Member Appeal Committee shall be formed in the technical meeting. No member of the committee can vote on dispute in which a player from himself is involved and in such cases, the reserves can take his place in the committee.
- 5. Withdrawal: A player can withdrew at any stage of the event after informing to chief arbiter in writing.
- 6. The organisor have reserve the right to reject any entry without assigning any reason. In such cases the entry fee needs to be refunded to the player rejected.
- 7. Personal chess clocks and boards are not allowed.
- 8. AICF Renewal/Registration (2022-23) is mandatory for players.
- 9. Players who do not have FIDE ID should send following details to the official mail id of the tournament (Name in full, Father Name, Date of Birth, State, City, contact number)
- 10. Registration of entries is through apchess.org only.
- 11. Prize Money is subject to Latest Income-Tax provisions.
- 12. Players qualified for more than one prize will be considered only for the higher prize money. Prize money will not be shared.
- 13. COVID regulations of Government of Andhra Pradesh & Government of India are applicable for the time being in force.
- 14. Disqualification: No participant will leave the venue before the Prize Distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter. The names of participants disregarding this rule will be forwarded to AICF for disciplinary action.
- 15. Interpretation: For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all. The Tournament Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without notice. Such changes will, however, be displayed in the tournament hall.



COVID PROTOCOL

- 1. All players are required to mandatorily adhere the Covid Protocol issued by Government of India/Government of Andhra Pradesh from time to time during championships.
- 2. Players have to sign the Self Declaration form on their arrival with respect to Covid-19.
- 3. All players are required to maintain social distancing and hand sanitization at all times.
- 4. Wearing of mask is mandatory at all times when the player is inside tournament hall.
- 5. Any symptomatic players will be removed from the championship as precaution. All players are obliged to obey this rule and no protest can be made against this decision of Organizing Committee.
- 6. All Officials and Arbiters will be fully vaccinated.
- 7. Sanitization of Chess Board and Chess pieces will be carried out at regular intervals.
- 8. Parents and accompanying persons are not allowed inside tournament hall at all times.
- 9. Organizers take all the measures for safe championship environment. However, in case any untoward situation arises, the players will not ask damages from Organizers/All India Chess Federation.
- 10. Due to any unforeseen scenario, if the event needs to be cancelled, then AICF's obligation is limited to refunding the entry fee paid by the players.
- 11. By enrolling for the events, the players are abide by all the terms and conditions of the championship for participation.


