











Thailand Pattaya Open 2024 Regulations

Tournament Regulations

- 1. This is an individual tournament, open to all players with FIDE ID number. If you do not have FIDE ID, please contact your country's Rating Officer.
- 2. There are four groups of play. When registering, players must indicate in which group they wish to play:
 - Open for players with a FIDE rating 1600 or above*
 - Amateur for players rated below 2000 or unrated
 Ratings from April 2024 FIDE rating list (national ratings may apply if validated by the organizer).
 - *Players under 1600 may participate in the Open group on payment of a higher entry fee. Unrated players are only eligible for Challenger.
- 3. FIDE (International Chess Federation) Law of Chess, rules and regulations shall apply. Results will be sent for FIDE rating calculations and are eligible for FIDE title norms.
- 4. Both groups will be played using a nine-round Swiss System. For the pairings, a Swiss Manager program will be used.
- 5. The matches shall be conducted according to the schedule, which will be made known to the respective players before the start of the tournament.
- 6. **For Open group**: Each player is accorded with a time control of 90 minutes for 40 moves + 30min for the rest of the game. There is a 30-second increment per move, starting from the move one.
 - **For Amateur group**: Each player is accorded with a time control of 90 minutes There is a 30-second increment per move, starting from the move one.
- 7. Five minutes before the games start, the Chief Arbiter shall make the announcement accordingly. If any player is not present within an hour after the game is started, he shall lose by default.
- 8. Players are not allowed to bring mobile phones or other electronic devices to the tournament hall. Any violation shall result in loss of game. Organizer will provide a deposit point outside the playing hall where, for a small fee, players can leave their electronic devices (at their own risk).
- 9. Officials and players should be smartly attired at all times while in the playing hall.
- 10. Tournament will follow all appropriate Thai health regulations concerning the wearing of face masks, social distancing, testing for infection or other regulations, valid at the tournament start. This will be announced before the tournament start.
- 11. Players may elect to take a bye for one round, with a half point awarded (during rounds 2–7 only). The offical form must be completed before the end of the previous round.
- 12. Any player unable to attend any round must inform the Arbiters' desk in writing before the end of the previous round. Failure to do so may result in not being paired for subsequent rounds.
- 13. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to these Regulations by notifying the players at the technical meeting. All player must attend the technical meeting.













Thailand Pattaya Youth&Senior 2024 – Regulations Tournament Regulations

- 1. This is an individual tournament, open to all players with FIDE ID number. If you do not have Fide ID number, please contact your country's Rating Officer.
- 2. FIDE (World Chess Federation) rules and regulations shall apply. Results will be sent for FIDE rating calculations.
- 3. Three groups will be played using the Swiss System, with 9 rounds. For the pairings, a Swiss Manager program will be used.
- 4. The matches shall be conducted according to the schedule, which will be made known to the respective players before the start of the tournament.
- 5. Each player is accorded with a time control of 90 minutes for the rest of the game. In addition there is 30 seconds increment per move, starting from the move 1.
- 6. Five minutes before the games start, the Chief Arbiter shall make the announcement accordingly. If any player is not present within an hour after the game is started, he shall lose by default.
- 7. Players are not allowed to bring mobile phones or other electronic devices to the tournament hall, any violation shall result in loss of game. Organizer will provide deposit point outside playing hall, where player can leave their mobile devices at their own risk.
- 8. Officials and players should be smartly attired at all times while in the playing hall.
- 9. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to these Regulations by notifying the players at the technical meeting tournament starts. All player must attend the technical meeting
- 10. Entitled player must not have reached his/her birthday, respectively, before January 1st, 2024.

- **Amateur Group**: 1st prize 10,000 Baht, 2nd 7,000 B, 3rd 5,000 B, 4th-5th each 3,000 B with additional prizes for 2-5 ranks Certificates for Best Juniors U18, Best Lady and Best Senior O55
- **Open Under 8**: 1st prize 3,000Baht, 2nd prize 2,000Baht, 3rd prize 1,000Baht with additional prizes for 4-5 medals and Trophy for Best Girls, medals for Best Girls 2-5.
- **Open Under 10**: 1st prize 4,000Baht, 2nd prize 3,000Baht, 3rd prize 2,000Baht with additional prizes for 4-5 medals and Trophy for Best Girls, medals for Best Girls 2-5.

- **Open Under 16**: 1st prize 7,000Baht, 2nd prize 5,000Baht, 3rd prize 3,000Baht with additional prizes for 4-5 medals, Trophy for Best Girls, medals for Best Girls 2-5.

Specials Prize for Youth U8, U10, U12, U14, U16

- 1st place team receive 1 medal each player, and 1 trophy team
- 2nd place team receive 1 medal each player
- 3rd place team receive 1 medal each player

Team prizes: Shall be awarded based on the total score of the top three players of a School or Federation. School or Federations with less than 3 players shall not be eligible for a team award. In the case of a tie, the tie-break scores of each player shall be determined.

(Will have a Senior Group if has the player After 55 olds 10 player up)

Senior Group: 1st Prize 7,000Baht, 2nd prize 5,000Baht, 3rd prize 3,000Baht with additional prizes for 4-5 medals, Trophy for Best Lady Senior.

Please note: Under Thai law, 5% tax shell be deducted from prize money. All prizes are in Thai Baht.

Arbiters

- Chief Arbiter: IA Patcharawee Brahmawong & IA
- In the event of dispute, player may submit an appeal to the Chief Arbiter by depositing a sum of Baht 3,000.00 (100.00USD) to the Chief Arbiter, who will in turn pass it to the Appeals Committee a decision. Appeals Committee's decision is final Deposit shall be returned if the appeal is successful. An appeal must be submitted to the Chief Arbiter within 30 minutes after the game is finished. Appeal Committee will be appointed at the Technical Meeting.
